SESA Programme: Trade Promotion through Standardisation

The Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (SIDA) has been supporting a two-year programme (January 2013-December 2014) implemented by the Swedish Standards Institute (SIS) to build institutional capacity within the South-east and South Asia (SESA) regions on standard setting and standard implementation. CUTS HRC is the SESA programme's partner organisation for the South-east Asia region. The programme has been extended by SIDA and SIS till June 2017.

During the reporting period, the 17th issue of the Newsletter on 'Standards and Quality' (also the last issue) has been prepared and distributed to the relevant stakeholders. In addition, final reporting to SIS has been done as of July 15, 2017.
